

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

SIGN ON / SCRUTINEERING - 4.30PM TO 6.00PM | RIDERS BRIEFING - 6.05PM | FIRST PRACTICE - 6.15PM | Permit: MRA2019/042

1. Jurisdiction

This event will be held under the Motorcycle Racing Association (Ireland) competition rules and standing regulations including any supplementary regulations that have or may be issued for the event.

2. Eligibility

The event is open to riders competing on solo motorcycles who are holding a current competition license issued by the MRA, MCUI (Southern Centre), ACU, SACU or Continental FMN. To score points in the championship however, you must be a member of Carrickfergus & District Motorcycle Club. Day licences are also available to residents of Ireland at a cost of £10.00 per day.

5. Classes

Premier Open	Grade 'A' competitors on any machine
Semi-Expert Open	Grade 'B' competitors on any machine
Clubman MX1	Clubman competitors on a MX1 machine (e.g. 250cc 2T, 350cc 4T, 450cc 4T)
Clubman MX2	Clubman competitors on a MX2 machine (e.g. 125cc 2T, 250cc 4T)
Veteran Open	Open competitors 40 years old and above on any machine
Minibike Open	Open class for minibikes (max wheel size: 17" front, 14" rear)
Ladies Open	Open class for female competitors on any machine

6. Points Scoring

The 2019 Carrickfergus & District Motorcycle Club Adult Grasstrack Championship will be contested over two rounds and the first three races (for each class) at each round will be manually lap scored. Points will then be awarded to the top fifteen finishers* in each race. Points will be awarded using the following points system:

1st - 25, 2nd - 20, 3rd - 16, 4th - 13, 5th - 11, 6th - 10, 7th - 9, 8th - 8, 9th - 7, 10th - 6, 11th - 5, 12th - 4, 13th - 3, 14th - 2, 15th - 1.

RIDERS MUST BE A MEMBER OF CARRICKFERGUS & DISTRICT M.C.C. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SCORE POINTS IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP. POINTS CANNOT BE RETROSPECIVELY AWARDED TO FINISHERS AFTER THE EVENT EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF A CLUB ERROR.

7. Entries

Entries must be completed in every detail on the official entry form (paper form or online) and accompanied by the full entry fee. Entry fees will only be returned in the event of a meeting being cancelled. The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry or return an entry already received. Pre-entry is preferred (and cheaper) but entries will be taken on the day while there is still space in the class.

8. Scrutineering of Machines and Signing on of Drivers/Passengers

Riders must present their machines and helmet in racing condition at Scrutineering. Crash helmets must bear the 2019 MRA Approved stamp. A helmet stamper will be on duty should inspection be required. A rider must not race a machine that hasn't been scrutineered. Riders must have their current competition licence available for inspection when signing on. Day Licences are available to residents of Northern & Southern Ireland.

9. No Tear-Off Policy (Environmental)

For this event the club has issued a tear-off ban. Any competitor that refuses to abide by this policy will be disqualified and their entry fee not refunded. The starter & clerk of course will be strictly enforcing this policy. It is permissible to use 'roll off' style goggles.

10. Course

The grasstrack course will be marked with posts, stakes, rope and tape. Course cutting may entail exclusion. Any driver who leaves the course must return to it at the point at which he left it except where it is advertant and no advantage is gained.

11. Practice

Practice will commence at 6.15pm sharp and riders will be briefed of the running order at the riders briefing by Clerk of Course. Riders must complete at least one lap of the course in practice which will be run in a controlled manner for a period between 6.15pm and 7.00pm approximately.

12. Method of starting

A clutch start with a back folding starting gate or flag will be employed.

13. Flag Signals

The International Code of Signals will be used and such signals must be obeyed while on track, failure to do so may result in disqualification. A yellow board with a black cross will indicate the last lap of the race.

14. Finish of a race

To be classified a finisher a competitor must have completed 75% of the distance covered by the race winner and have crossed the finishing line within five minutes after the race winner has finished.

15. Stopping a race

A race if stopped prematurely for reasons of force majeure, it may be re-run at the discretion of the promoters with the permission of the stewards. A race will be re-run should there be a false start. If a race is stopped because of a rider/s lying on the course that rider or riders will not be allowed to restart the race.

16. Any rider refusing medical attention will not be allowed to race further on the day.

17. The club reserves the right to move any competitor to a different grade or group.
